To all churches who would like a custom tract, I have left six lines of text free space for adding your church contact information. This will eliminate the need to have to print and add labels to the tracts.

The title of the tract is a catch phrase used in Plautdietsch and is a conversation starter as well as a statement equivalent to the English, "You know what!?". The theme, a know-so salvation, is built into the title through the word "Weetst" which is directly translated "know you". The greatest argument amongst the Mennonites is that you can not know that you are saved. That is why I chose to do a tract with the Gospel along with a theme. The main points of the tract are as follows.

1. We have to understand and agree with God that we are sinners.
2. We have to understand that there is a penalty for our sin.
3. We have to understand and agree with God that there is nothing we can do for salvation.
4. There is hope and assurance in Jesus Christ. In Jesus we can stand before God holy, perfect, and righteous.
5. We have to trust in Jesus Christ as our only hope.

Point number two is very thorough in order to do away with a general judgment mentality that the Mennonites have from Matthew 24. This also does away with the idea that salvation is based on works, and at this general judgment it is either Heaven or Hell. The choice is made now! Point number three is needed to have them see from the Bible that their works are not a part of salvation.
