#### Pray!

Please pray for labourers, specifically for reaching the Mennonite people. Bolivia is a land locked country and is a great hub to reach the Mennonite people as there are unreached Mennonites in four out of five bordering countries. We are very excited about getting to work and pioneering a work for God in Bolivia! I have been reading in Ezra and Nehemiah recently and am pumped up to do something for God! I am excited to see what we would deem the impossible, to be done. Please pray for the need of a Bible translation into the Plautdietsch language. Also, pray for some outreach tools I am working on. I am working on a Gospel tract in Plautdietsch with an emphasis on the fact that we can know we have eternal life. I am also working on a video recording of my testimony in Plautdietsch to air via social platforms and on our website. Life stories are a big part of the Mennonite culture and sharing my testimony will be a great way to reach Mennonites. After that I want to preach a Gospel message as well as a message on the security of the believer. Please pray for the power of God to work through these means to reach these precious people! I would also like to start a channel via You-Tube and preach a series of messages. This will help get sound preaching into the ears of those interested as well as help me establish myself in preaching in the Plautdietsch language. To practice hard now will make it easier when we are on the field. It is one thing to speak this language but another thing to preach in it as spiritual and Biblical terms are not used in everyday speaking.

We had the privilege of sharing our ministry in the United States for the first time this month. We had a great visit with the pastor and church family. The pastor had a great testimony of battling oesophageal cancer and how God healed him. There was a couple in this church who were missionaries to Gambia, Africa for 40 years.
